

The meeting started at 3 pm with a silent prayer. Dr Sheeja Mathews, Head of the Dept. presided over the meeting. Addressing the members, she shared the importance of introducing a new paper, related to the 'Chemistry of Advanced Materials' in the syllabus of Semester IV - MSc programme. Dr Anirudhan T.S., Prof. Dept of Chemistry, University of Kerala, Kariavattom suggested that the topics that are to be included in the paper should be of present day relevance.

The Board of studies mooted the topics to be included in the paper. Finally, after a lively discussion the following decisions were taken.

The title of the newly introduced paper is 'Chemistry of Advanced Materials'. It has five units and the total marks awarded is 100, which includes 30M for continuous assessment and 70M for ESE. The total marks

for Semester IV - MSc is retained as such. However, from the present distribution of marks, 50 M are removed from project evaluation and 50 M from that of viva-voce, which makes a total of 100 marks.

The Board also decided that a copy of the scheme and syllabus may be forwarded to the 'Academic Council' for ratification, at the earliest so that this paper can be included in the syllabus of Semester IV - MSc of 2016 admission onwards.
